

St Bonaventure's School Improvement Plan 2022-23



Priority 1- All children receive high quality PE and music lessons

- At least one PE lesson a week will be taught by the class teacher.
- Introduction of a PE scheme of work- The PE Hub- to ensure consistency of skills and progression.
- Bristol Beacon will be supporting teaching staff to implement the revised music curriculum.
- Increased opportunities for all children to take part in musical events and opportunities including both vocal and instrumental ensembles.

Priority 2- Explore and build strategies across the curriculum to respond to children's different learning styles and cognitive barriers to learning

- Education Endowment Foundation, EEF, used by staff to support implementation of research driven approaches.
- Pupil case studies will be used by middle and senior leaders to track and monitor progress and outcomes.
- Shared understanding of metacognition- how we learn.
- Focus on the use of concrete material to support the whole class teaching of maths and smaller intervention groups- Numicon will be a focus.
- Implementation of research based spelling and reading interventions across KS1 and KS2.

Priority 3- Support staff and children in recognising and addressing SEMH needs to establish a mentally healthy school environment where staff, parents and pupils feel that their voice is heard and they are part of the St Bons community

- Catholic social teaching is embedded through St Bons faith awards.
- Strategies to support individual, group and class reflection and regulation are identified and embedded.
- PSHE/RSE curriculum map in place.
- Pupil voice is effective and informs SIP priorities.
- Parents supported to understand the PACE model.
- Strategies in place to support staff to manage workload.
