Dear parents and carers,

Thank you to everyone who attended the virtual parents' information sessions this week. For parents of Reception pupils, your session will be on Wednesday 29th September at 4.00pm via a link on Google classroom.

I am aware that a number of parents had difficulties accessing the session due to issues with the technology. This is a new platform and we are in the process of ironing out the difficulties. Thank you for your patience. I am also aware that the timing of the 3.30pm session made it difficult for parents to access the session after collecting their children from school. All teachers have therefore put a copy of their presentation on to Google classroom. You can access this by logging in using your child's log in details.

I want to use this opportunity to remind you of the revised arrangements in place for dropping off your children from Monday 27th September:

- All children will enter school through the front gate the back gate will no longer be in use
- Parents to continue to drop off at the gate (please do not come onto the playground at drop off)
- At 8.30am, the gates will be opened by Headteacher / Deputy Head
- KS2 pupils can be dropped off between 8.30-8.40am. Please be aware that, if dropping KS2 children with siblings, staff won't be on duty until 8.40am. Parents will therefore need to use their judgement if dropping off siblings with KS2 children before 8.40am. Children arriving between 8.30 and 8.40am should go straight to their class lines
- Reception parents are invited to come on to the playground with the children from 8.40am
- At 8.40am class teachers will come onto the playground to meet pupils.

Home learning contingency plan

Please find attached with this newsletter the most recent home learning contingency plan. This sets out the actions that will be taken with regard to home learning in the event of a child not being able to attend school due to contracting Covid-19 and/or a year group or whole school closure due to an outbreak of Covid-19 or a regional/national lockdown. Nessy

A small number of parents will have received an email from the software company Nessy this week. As part of our focus on spelling, a small number of identified children from each year group in year 2-6 have received a log in for this spelling app. This will be used in school to support them with spelling. At the moment pupils will not need to log in at home. We are in the process of setting pupils up in school and supporting them to become independent in using the app. If your child does not have difficulties with spelling, they will not receive a log in.

Parents' evening

Last term our parent focus group discussed the advantages and disadvantages of virtual and face to face parents' evenings. We used this discussion to inform the organisation of parents' evening this year.

This term parents' evening will take place on Thursday 14th October and Tuesday 19th October between 4.00pm and 7.00pm. These meetings will take place remotely via SchoolCloud. We plan to make the parents' evenings in term 4 face to face.

Parking

I'm sorry to have to include a parking 'nag' but we have been contacted by a neighbour who is concerned at the number of parents parking inconsiderately on the streets close to school. Please do bear our neighbours in mind when you're parking near school.
