Dear parents and carers,

Change of learning platform

You will be aware from my email earlier this week that we are planning to move away from the class pages of the school website. Working alongside our parent focus group we have identified the need to move to a system that would support online learning whilst also ensuring a consistent layout across year groups.

I am pleased to inform you that we are now using Google Classroom. To access your child's class you need to log in using the same user details your child used to access Goggle meetings at https://classroom.google.com/ Class teachers will be using these pages to share homework and to provide a summary of the weeks learning. Paper copies of homework will also continue to be sent home.

Reminder of changes to collection arrangements from Monday 13th September

The following information was shared in a letter to all parents on Wednesday 8th September:

From **Monday 13**th **September** we will be returning to all pupils leaving via the front playground.

Pupils in Reception, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 should be collected by their parents from the external classroom fire door that exits onto the school playground.

Pupils in Year 4, 5 and 6 will be brought onto the playground by their class teacher for collection.

Please can all parents collect youngest siblings first.

I would kindly ask that you collect your children and then promptly leave the playground avoiding gathering in groups to chat.

The playground gates will open just before 3.15pm and close promptly at 3.25pm in order to allow our after-school clubs and activities to operate safely.

Any parents arriving late to collect their children should go to the school office.

Change of date - last day of the school year - Thursday 21st July

In acknowledgement of the additional Bank Holiday for the Queen's Platinum Jubilee on 3rd June 2022, the Department for Education has agreed to reduce the minimum number of teaching days to 189 meaning the total school year will be 194 days.
